PRE-REQUISITE FOR ONLINE
ASSESSMENT – TCS NQT

Important Note:

Current TCS NQT Sep 2021 exam cycle there are three group of students who will be taking the exam.

1. Applicants who have registered ONLY in Ninja portal – DT/CT id will be their reference id for login (**Scores will be shared only with TCS**)
2. Applicants who have applied in BOTH Ninja portal and in TCS iON NQT page - NQT Registration number will be their reference id for login (**Score card will be published to students only for the subjects they have applied in TCS iON**)
3. Applicants who have applied ONLY in TCS iON NQT page - NQT Registration number will be their reference id for login (**Score card will be published to students for the subject which they have applied in TCS iON**)

Candidates should reach the Exam Center as per the Registration time mentioned in their Admit Card.

Link to launch the Exam for Online Mode. Exam events scheduled for the candidate will be visible only on the Exam day or one day prior to the exam in the candidate login.

Applicants must start the Registration for the exam as per the Registration time provided in their exam schedule which is one hour prior to their exam time.

Pre-Requisites for taking the online Exam from home:

1) Availability of Webcam:

The system to be used must have either an integrated Webcam or an attached Webcam.

a) Ensure the Webcam is functioning. To check this –

i) Open Webcam application installed on the system (e.g., Type ‘Webcam’ in search bar to locate Application).

ii) Take few sample pictures and video of self.

iii) Access the following [link](#) . Click on the dropdown and Select the camera

Provide the permission to access your camera. View your self-video from your camera.

If you are still not able to see yourself after selecting the camera OR camera dropdown is not populating automatically, use any other browser for detecting camera or change your camera.

b) Ensure uninterrupted and exclusive access to the Webcam.

c) Close all third-party applications installed on your system to capture images or videos from your system, including YouCam

d) Uninstall YouCam software for the duration of the assessment or any other external webcam software (any third party/vendor software) needs to be uninstalled prior to starting the assessment

2) System Hardware Requirements

a) RAM: 4GB of RAM

b) Processor: Intel Core i3 (or equivalent) and above

c) HDD: 100 MB of free space

3) Active, dedicated Internet bandwidth

Active & Consistent internet connectivity is required throughout the session. In case of Wi-Fi connection ensure that, at the time of attempting the assessment limited users are connected to the same network. This will ensure uninterrupted session.

Minimum Internet bandwidth required – 2 MBPS. Recommended is 5 MBPS

4) Launcher Details

TCS iON Launcher application (iLEON) once downloaded can be used for future assessments. You need not download the launcher every time before the assessment. System upgrades the launcher if any update is available while launching.

5) Details of OS and Supported Browsers for iLEON App

- Windows 10, Windows 7 (Service Pack 1) - Google Chrome - All versions.
- Windows 10, Windows 7 (Service Pack 1) - Internet Explorer - All versions.
- Windows 10 - Firefox - Not supported
- Windows 7 (Service Pack 1) - Firefox - Version 46 to 56.
- Ubuntu 16 (All browser versions)
- Safari – Not Supported.
- Ubuntu 18 and 20 is currently not supported
- Android /iOS mobile platform - not supported
- MAC OS – Not supported.

Note: In case of a desktop or laptop running Windows 7 operating system, please check and ensure it has the latest Service Pack installed.

6) Firewall & Proxy Setting

For a system with active Firewall, ensure that the firewall setting is turned “off” for the duration of assessment.

Disable Firewall and Proxy using below steps:

- 1) Go to Control Panel and turn off Firewall Settings for the exam duration
- 2) Go to Browser Settings and disable Proxy Settings for the exam duration

7) Browser Setting

Recommended Google Chrome browser for best experience updated with the latest version available

Please verify the following key check points in browser setting before starting self-registration or the Assessment.

Zoom Level:

Set the browser zoom level to 100%.

Please access the zoom level setting by clicking on the three vertical dots displayed on the right-hand corner of your browser window as shown

Camera Access:

Access to camera should be “allowed” for browser.

On google chrome, please navigate to **Settings->Privacy and Security->Site Settings>Permission> Camera**

Pop-Up Blocked:

Enable Pop-ups to “**Always Allow**”, if prompted

Browser Cache:

Kindly clear browsing history and cache before launching the assessment

8) Full Admin Rights on the Desktop / Laptop

In case using a system managed by an Organization, Administrator access may be required to disable anti-virus protection program.

A personal system with full access (administrative level) and control is recommended

9) Anti-virus

Anti-Virus programs running in background could generate system alerts from time to time.

These system alerts would impact running of Assessment Application and possibly stop ongoing assessment session.

Kindly disable/uninstall all Antivirus and disable System auto updates of anti-virus and all security patches. You can revert to your original settings post the assessment

10) System Screen Resolution

Please ensure system screen resolution is set to 1024*720 only.

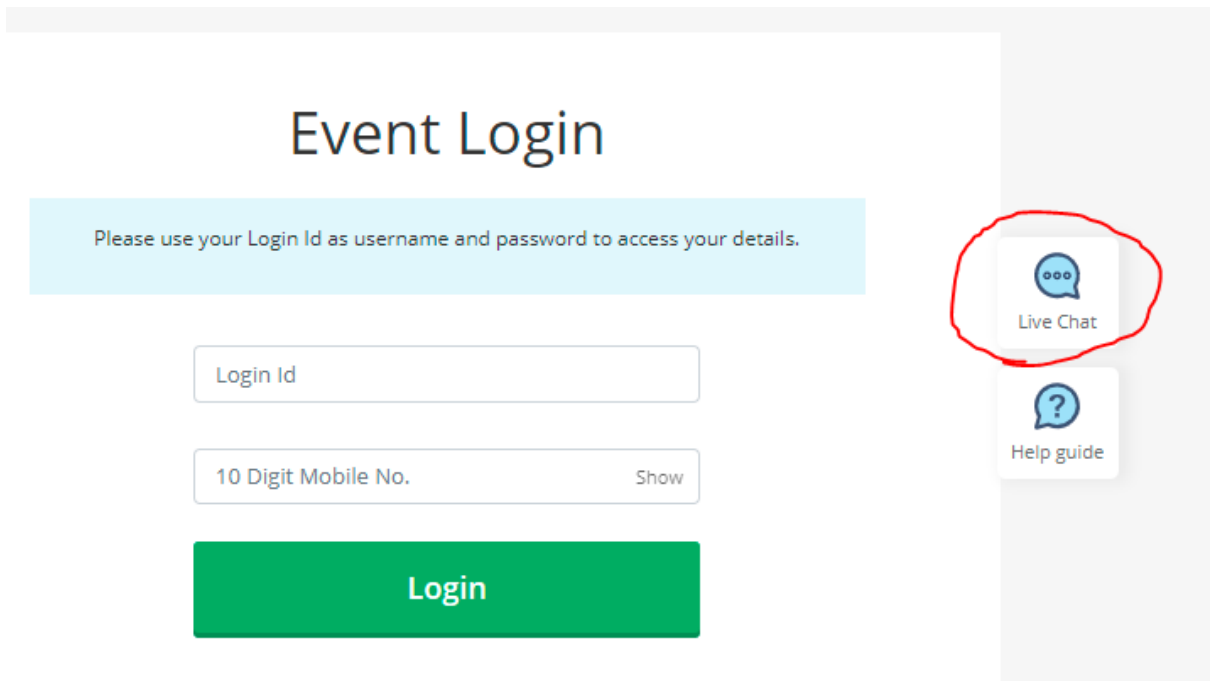

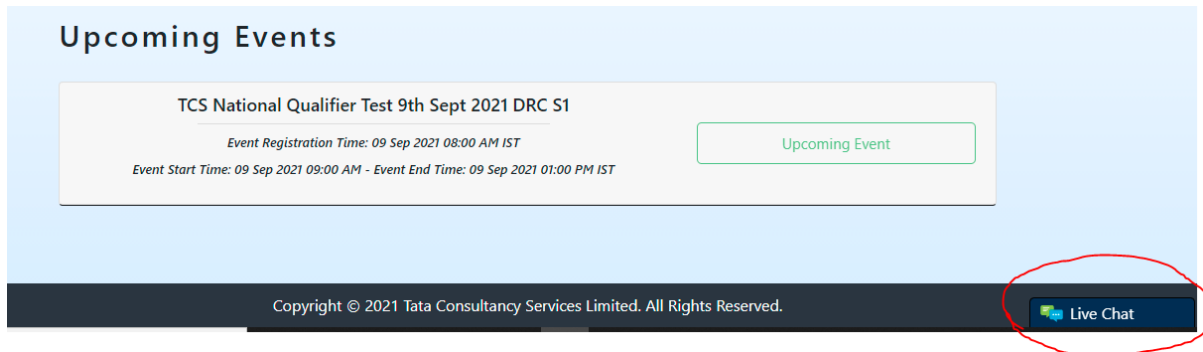
Support 1 for Technical Issues on Exam day for Online Mode:
